## Easy to assemble

Its unique pre-cut click-to-construct design makes it easy to assemble on any location: no tools, glue, nails, screws or staples required. From unwrapping to deployment in just a few minutes. Follow the three easy steps demonstrated below.



### Step 1

Remove packaging and check the contents to see if all six parts are present.



### Step 2

Arrange the parts as shown, making sure to identify headboard and footboard, left/right side panels, and inside/outside of panels.

### Step 3

Click-to-construct: follow the order as shown (A to E).

**Note:** click and close lid (F) only after remains have been placed in the coffin.
